WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

PARENTS NEED TO FILL OUT ALL INFO ON FORMS...PLEASE PRINT! DO NOT LET YOUR CAMPER DO THIS. FORMS - Camper Registration, Parent/Camper NOTARIZED agreement, and Check

Make sure you know your local church's deadline for turning in the camper forms and check. Give your registration form, parent/camper NOTARIZED agreement form, and check to the representative from your local Nazarene church. Do NOT send anything to the District Office. **Parents will not have access to the mailing address because ALL forms and checks need to be given to your local Nazarene Church Camp Coordinator in order for them to be mailed in.**

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW:

Closed Campground Policy: Once campers arrive at Pinecrest, they will not be allowed to leave the grounds and return, unless cleared through the Directors prior to the start of camp. There are NO VISITORS allowed. This is for the safety of your camper. Please abide by this policy.

REGISTRATION AND ENDING TIMES: Registration begins at 10 a.m. on Monday. Camp ends Friday once the camper receives her lunch.

GENERAL PACKING LIST

THINGS TO BRING:

Bedding (sleeping bag or sheets/blanket and pillow)

Towels/washcloths

*Clothing (play type clothes are fine, even for chapel services)

At least 2 pairs of shoes (one that can get wet) **Tennis shoes are a must!**

Swimwear (girls must wear 1-piece suits or a dark-colored t-shirt over a 2-piece or one-piece that shows tummy and sides**)

Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, comb, brush, toothbrush, etc.)

Bible/notebook/pencil

Flashlight with batteries.

Medications (see application for details)

THINGS NOT TO BRING:

CD/ipods/MP3 players
Game boys or other electronic devices
Roller blades
Toys included
Drugs or alcohol
Pets

Walkie-talkies
CELL PHONES
Weapons of any kind
Cigarettes
Food or snacks
Fireworks

NO CASH (monies needed for meals to and from camp need to be given to sponsor to hold)

These things will be confiscated with the possibility of the camper being sent home. (See Parent/Camper Agreement form.)

***DRESS POLICY:** We strive to honor God in every way during our week at camp. Modesty is the way we dress is one way to show respect and reverence to God. WE ask that all campers and staff members follow these simple guidelines when packing for camp.

No mid drift shirts, short shorts, spaghetti straps, basically anything that would be inappropriate at school.

****SWIMWEAR:** Girls MUST wear 1-piece swimsuits or a dark-colored t-shirt over their 2-piece suits or 1- piece suits that reveal tummy or sides. All campers must wear clothing over swimwear while walking to and from swimming areas.

While packing, use this simple rule: "If in doubt, leave it out."
